

Guide to Running a GSD League National Koerung

The GSDL British Regional Group manages the National Koerung Scheme on behalf of the GSD League of Great Britain. All correspondence should be sent to gsdlnationalkoerung@gmail.com

It is mandatory that spectators are not restricted from the event. Details of the event will be automatically published on the GSDL website once the event has been approved.

THINGS TO CONSIDER BEFORE APPLING

- The entry fee for a GSDL National Koerung is £75 for GSDL members and £100 for members of other WUSV member clubs.. £25 of this is payable to the GSDL-BRG and £50 is retained by the host club towards costs.
- You must have the following available at the Event Secure outdoor facilities, two IGP hides, a table and gazebo, a measuring stick, a tape measure, weighing scales and a gun.
- Access to an approved GSDL Koermeister and a GSDL licensed helper who has been approved by the appointed Koermeister.

Step One – Send an application form to hold a National Koerung to gsdlnationalkoerung@gmail.com. This must be done a minimum of 4 weeks before the event.

The **GSDL BRG Secretary** will confirm that the event is approved and issue an event reference number. Once approved, the event will be advertised on the GSD league Facebook page and website and the BRG and WDG website

Step Two – Issue Entrants Information Document and Link to Online Entry Form

Entry Fee must be £75

All entries to be submitted a minimum of 10 days before the event – no entries will be accepted after that cut-off

Step Three – The Koermeister will check the entry forms and contact the event secretary in the case of any queries. The Event Secretary will be issued with a list of all confirmed entries at least 3 days prior to the event.

Note that it is a requirement that the owner and handler is a member of the GSDL or any WUSV member organisation. The dog must be resident in the UK at the time of the event.

All of the entry criteria, ie DNA, Hips, elbows, AD, IGP etc must be achieved PRIOR to the Koerung. Entries will not be accepted with any qualifying criteria pending – including health test results.

Step Four – Hold the Koerung

Liaise with your koermeister on layout of the equipment and running the event.



All entrants must be allocated a ring number and handlers must wear their ring bib at all times in the ring.

Collect all pedigrees, health test results, workbooks and show grading cards at the start of the event.

The koermeister will record the koerung details during the event and will input them to the database personally.

The koermeister will stamp and sign all pedigrees for those dogs which pass the koerung on the day.

The GSDL BRG Secretary will issue Koerung Reports directly to owners after the event.

The GSDL BRG Secretary will issue a list of dog's which have passed the National Koerung to the GSD League Website Administrator and will ensure that it is kept up to date.

Rules for participation

- The original pedigree, health test results, workbook and show grading card have to be presented at the event. All qualifications MUST be achieved prior to the event.
- Publication of participants on the GSDL Website is mandatory 3 days before the event.

Holding the event

- Please also take note of the current GSD League National Koerung Rules.
- There must be no deviation from the above rules or the schedule as set in the program
- The Koerung Tests are controlled by the Koermeister and the Koermeister decisions and opinions are final.
