### GSD League of Great Britain Code of Conduct For Members



#### **PURPOSE**

This Code of Conduct sets out the standards of behaviour expected from all members of the GSD League of Great Britain. It fosters a respectful, ethical, and supportive environment for individuals passionate about German Shepherd Dogs.

### 1. WELFARE AND CARE OF DOGS

- Prioritise the health, safety, and well-being of all dogs.
- Provide appropriate nutrition, veterinary care, exercise, and socialisation.
- Avoid practices that cause unnecessary stress, harm, or suffering.
- Train and handle dogs in accordance with animal welfare legislation that prevails at the time.

## 2. ETHICAL BREEDING PRACTICES

- Breed only from physically and temperamentally sound dogs with appropriate health testing.
- Maintain accurate records of pedigrees, health tests, and breeding outcomes.
- Avoid excessive breeding and ensure responsible puppy placement.
- Never support puppy farming or unethical commercial breeding.

### 3. SHOWING AND COMPETITION

- Exhibit dogs respectfully and professionally.
- Accept judges' decisions with grace.
- Avoid misrepresentation of dogs' condition or behaviour.

### 4. IGP SPORT AND TRAINING

- Respect IGP rules and promote fair competition.
- Ensure dogs are physically and mentally prepared.
- Accept judges' decisions with grace.

### **5. CONDUCT TOWARD OTHERS**

- Treat all individuals with courtesy, honesty, and respect.
- Avoid defamatory, discriminatory, or aggressive behaviour.

- Represent the League with integrity in all interactions.
- Avoid statements that damage the League's reputation.
- Use social media responsibly and respectfully.

## 7. COMPLIANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY

- Abide by relevant laws, Kennel Club regulations, and League policies.
- Cooperate with investigations into breaches of conduct.
- Understand that violations may result in disciplinary action.

### 8. COMMITMENT TO IMPROVEMENT

- Engage in ongoing education about dog welfare and breed standards.
- Share knowledge constructively and respectfully.
- Promote the German Shepherd Dog as a versatile and loyal breed.
